Supplies For Primary Kids

Providing school supplies is one of the simplest and most impactful ways we can break down barriers to education for children in need. In Cambodia's public schools, students must arrive with their own notebooks, pens and pencils. With families often surviving on subsistence farming and caring for multiple children, even a \$5 set of supplies can be an impossible cost. Too often, parents are forced to choose one child to attend school, hoping they can teach their siblings at home.

Just \$5.57 buys one primary school student all the supplies they need for the year. This grant helps ensure all 1528 students in our programs can step into the classroom, and opens the door for all children in the village to attend school, not just the few who can afford it.
