Description

The families of these students desperately want their children educated — they understand it is the only path to a better future. But in our most severely impoverished villages, wanting isn't enough. In many of the communities BFT serves, 60% of children leave school to help support their families — working on the subsistence farm, because without those hands the family doesn't eat. A school is often 25 kilometres away or more. During the wet season, roads flood and become impassable for weeks. Transport costs are beyond reach, and daily farm labour cannot stop. Without a safe place to stay, there is simply no way for these children to attend. The dormitory removes every one of those barriers: 30 students receive gender-segregated accommodation — bunk beds, daily meals, clean sanitation, and full supervision by resident teachers — five nights a week, every week of the school year.



Your Impact

Thirty students who would otherwise never complete secondary school get to stay, study, eat, and sleep safely. Their families, freed from impossible transport costs and the daily pressure of needing their child's labour, can focus on their own work without constant worry. Many of these students are the first in their families to sit a high school exam. And when they graduate, find work, and begin to earn — they do what educated children across our villages have always done: they send money home, support younger siblings into school, and become the economic foundation their families have never had. One dormitory place doesn't just educate one child. It begins to lift an entire family out of poverty — and that change is permanent.
